Newark Beth Israel Medical Center (NBIMC), a 673-bed regional care, teaching hospital established in 1901, is an affiliate of the Saint Barnabas Health Care System. NBIMC's more than 800 physicians and 3,200 employees provide residents of Newark, neighboring communities and across the state with compassionate, innovative and superior care. NBIMC is widely recognized, most recently: named among the nation's top 50 hospitals for specialty care in heart and heart surgery by U.S. News and World Report; recipient of the Gold Performance Achievement Award from the American Heart Association; KidsFit Newark, a pediatric weight management program, honored by the New Jersey Hospital Association; NBI successfully participated in a six-way renal transplant in 2009; and performed the state's first therapeutic hypothermia procedure to prevent brain injury.

NBI's renowned areas of specialty include: Cardiology services and cardiac surgery, heart transplants, lung transplants (NJ's only program), kidney and pancreas transplants, robotic surgery, electrophysiology, pacemaker and defibrillator services, cancer and blood disorders and sleep disorders.

Children's Hospital of New Jersey (CHNJ), New Jersey's premier pediatric facility, offers medical expertise in more than 30 pediatric sub-specialties for children from newborn to adolescent years. The facility provides an

atmosphere of caring and warmth that complements the extraordinary medical care that is delivered by medical and surgical specialists who are all dedicated exclusively to children's health. The hospital's comprehensive inpatient and outpatient pediatric services include the busiest Pediatric Emergency Department in the state, New Jersey's largest Level III Designated Regional Perinatal Center, Pediatric Intensive Care Unit, Neonatal Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS)/Apnea Center, The Valerie Fund Children's Center for Cancer and Blood Disorders, Neonatal ICU with New Jersey's only ECMO unit, HIV/AIDS treatment for children, and a sexual and child abuse program as well as preventive programs that promote wellness in the community.

Beneficiaries of the 2010 Partners in Progress Dinner, our **Pre-natal and Women's Health Care Programs**, are remarkable within the community and the region. NBIMC offers comprehensive Obstetrical and Gynecology services to women in the greater Newark area as well as the four surrounding counties. Our Women's Health Center and the Mother/Baby Pavilion offer state-of-the-art care by highly skilled physicians, midwives, and nurses. In 2009, our staff saw over 22,000 patients and delivered nearly 4,000 infants. The Medical Center's highly sophisticated equipment and facilities include 3-D and 4-D ultrasound technology, the latest generation da Vinci[®] Surgical System for robotic-assisted gynecological procedures, and a new labor and delivery unit that

features five private labor/delivery and recovery suites. Both routine and high-risk patients receive the same excellence of care complemented by the wide range of specialists in women's health.

Newark Beth Israel Medical Center is a leader in diagnosing and managing high-risk pregnancies. Preconception/prenatal genetic counseling services are provided by a board-certified genetic counselor at the high-volume, high-risk NBIMC perinatal practice. Maternal Fetal Medicine subspecialties provide cutting-edge diagnostic procedures including genetic testing and fetal blood transfusion. NBIMC has been a state-designated Regional Perinatal Center since 1981 and provides expert intensive care for mothers and infants in a compassionate environment. Babies are referred by more than 30 hospitals in four counties.

Newark Beth Israel has a deep understanding of the specific health care needs of women. Among a wide range of services offered for women are programs for breast health, with two clinics each month, an active breast cancer service, urogynecology, reproductive endocrinology, gynecology, robotic surgery, cardiac health, arthritis, lupus and osteoporosis programs, and a bloodless medicine program.
